INTRODUCTION

As part of the 2025 International Scuba Diving Hall of Fame (ISDHF) Induction Ceremony, which will honour an all-female slate of inductees, high school students across the Cayman Islands are invited to participate in the 2025 ISDHF Poster Competition.

The competition aims to highlight the invaluable contributions of women in diving and watersports, while encouraging youth creativity, raising awareness, and promoting appreciation for the role of women in the maritime and tourism industries.

OBJECTIVES

The 2025 ISDHF Poster Competition seeks to:

- Encourage youth participation in cultural and heritage-based tourism initiatives.
- Educate students about the significant impact of women in diving and watersports.
- Inspire creativity and self-expression through visual art.
- Build national pride by showcasing Caymanian and International talent.

GOALS

- To increase awareness of the historical and present-day contributions of maritime tourism.
- To support the development of youth engagement in the arts and tourism education.

BENEFITS

- Increased appreciation for the history and significance of diving and watersports in the Cayman Islands.
- Development of artistic expression, storytelling, and research skills.
- Recognition of students' creative work on a national platform.
- Opportunity for young artists to be featured at high-profile tourism events.

COMPETITION RULES & GUIDELINES

Eligibility: Open to students ages 10–17 in the Cayman Islands.

Theme: "Women in Diving & Watersports"

Participants are encouraged to explore and depict the accomplishments, contributions, and spirit of women in these fields through visual art.





POSTER FORMAT & MEDIUM:

- Size: Standard 22" x 28" Bristol or poster board
- Medium: Paint, pencil, pastels and mixed media
- High-res Photo submission
- Each submission must include:
 - A title
 - A short artist statement (maximum 150 words) explaining the inspiration behind the piece

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Each poster must be clearly labeled with:

- Student's Full Name
- Name of Institution/ Homeschool
- Grade Level

Students are required to submit a high-resolution photo of their artwork via the online form (https://wkf.ms/4inS9bG) and deliver the physical artwork to the Government Administration Building on or before Friday, September 5th, by 4:30 PM.

JUDGING GUIDELINES

A panel comprising representatives from the public, private sectors as well as the ISDHF Board will evaluate submissions based on the following criteria:

- 1. Creativity & Originality 40 points
- 2. Relevance to the Theme 30 points
- 3. Artistic Quality & Presentation 20 points
- 4. Impact of Message- 10 points

2nd Place:

- Gift Card CI\$50.00
- Display of artwork at both events

3rd Place:

- Invitation for winner and one guest to both events
- Cash Prize: CI\$150
- Gift Card CI\$50.00
- Display of artwork at both events

- Opportunity for artwork to be featured on official ISDHF digital platforms
